Adding to the picturesque surroundings are the several fresh water streams that crisscross the hills and land, and a natural perennial waterfall which cascades into the river

The development includes 27 villas, many of which are now sold out, ranging from two-bedroom, single floor homes to four-bedroom, triple floor ones. Drawing inspiration from the natural surroundings to create a luxurious and comfortable living experience, each of the villas offers residents a tranquil and serene getaway from the hustle and worries of city life. In addition, since the site is surrounded by reserve forest land, residents can rest assured that there will be no future developments around it.

The present property is one of a series of highly desirable and much sought-after limited edition 3 bedroom villas admeasuring approximately 3600 square feet and occupies one of the best locations within the development, a stone's throw away from the river. This villa comes replete with the latest high-end fittings and fixtures. This villa offers its residents a clear view of the River Ganges with well-manicured lawns and gardens that stretch right up to the river bank which is a few short steps below.

Homage has been conceived and planned by the Singapore based firm, SCDA Architects, and exquisitely executed to provide residents with an ethereal experience that makes the most of the area's abundance of fresh air, flowing water and natural sunlight. The muted sounds of Ganges flowing by and the soft chirping of the forest birds add to each villa's peaceful ambiance. A short walk downhill from the property is a beautiful, white-sand beach, where residents may relax, sunbathe, or take a cleansing dip in the holy river.

The external finishing of each villa and the landscaping, by Tierra from Australia, has also been conceptualized to complement the location and atmosphere. While the villas are built with the best natural materials including Sukabhumi stone sourced from Indonesia and Burma teak, the landscaping includes two streams that flow through the property, and greenery handpicked from all over the country. Each villa is surrounded by plants and shrubs, ensuring the privacy of every resident in this open community development.

With either a view of the majestic Ganges, or of the hills through which it descends from the snow-capped Himalayas, each of these contemporary hillside villas seems to merge with its picturesque surroundings. Designed keeping nature in mind, with clean surfaces of wood, water and stone, each villa comes with spacious living areas and every amenity needed in a luxurious home away from home.





Location Profile:

A quaint town on the banks of the holy River Ganges, Rishikesh is considered one of the most sanctified places to visit in India, and plays host to the famous Kumbh Mela once every four years. Besides being one of the world's most renowned centers for the teaching and practice of yoga and meditation, Rishikesh is the gateway to the Himalayas and a great location for water sports, particularly whitewater rafting on the rapids of the Ganges. Rajaji National Park, located round the corner, is an important component of the ecosystem of the Himalayan foothills or Shivaliks, and is a veritable paradise for nature lovers and wildlife enthusiasts. Other nearby attractions include Laxman Jhoola, the Kunjapuri Temple and Rishikund. Rishikesh is well connected by rail, road and air; the nearest railhead is Haridwar which is about twenty one kilometers away, and the closest airport, Jolly Grant in Dehradun, is about the same distance from Rishikesh.
